



EU COUNTRIES

- Member States (MS) including their outermost regions
- The Overseas Countries and Territories (OCTs) linked to the MS

Any type of organisation can apply for Horizon Europe funding!

At least 3 partner organisations from 3 different EU or Associated countries!



NON-EU COUNTRIES

- Countries associated to Horizon Europe (AC)
- Low and middle income countries: See <u>HE Programme</u> <u>Guide</u>
- Other countries (not automatically eligible for funding, only when announced in the call or exceptionally if their participation is **essential**)



SPECIFIC CASES

- Affiliated entities established in countries eligible for funding.
- EU bodies
- International organisations (IO):
 - International European research organisations are eligible for funding.








